Take a moment of reflection at the Rigi Kulm mountain chapel before descending by cogwheel train to Vitznau. There, embark on a serene one-hour boat cruise across Lake Lucerne, surrounded by breathtaking natural scenery.</p> <p>Arriving at the Lucerne pier, wander through the medieval streets of the historic Old Town, where you'll see iconic landmarks such as the Chapel Bridge, the baroque Jesuit Church, and the impressive Culture and Convention Centre (KKL) designed by architect Jean Nouvel. Stroll the lakeside promenade lined with grand Belle Époque hotels, visit the famous Lion Monument, and perhaps enjoy a snack, drink, or souvenir shopping.</p> <p>Take a relax journey back to Zurich</p> |
